Physiological Psychology

Roots of Physiological Psychology, Methods of Physiological Psychology, Neural communication, Human Nervous system: structure and functions, The Brain: Structure and functions of different Lobes, Receptors, effectors and adjustment mechanisms, Sensory processing: Vision, Audition, Gustation, Olfaction, Somato-senses, Vestibular System and Kinesthetic System, The Endocrine system, Genetics, Physiology of Motivation – Hunger, thirst & sex, Physiology of emotion and stress, Physiology of Learning and Memory, Sleep and waking: stages, disorders and physiological mechanism of sleep and walking. Neuropsychological assessment.

Developmental Psychology

Developmental Process-Nature and principles, factors influencing development- Biogenic, Sociogenic, Psychogenic, Stages of Development, Different domains of development: Sensory- motor, cognitive, language and emotional, social and moral, Theories of Development – Psychoanalytic, Behavioristic and Cognitive.

General Psychology

Definition, Nature, Origin, Scope, Schools of Psychology, Perspectives in Psychology, Methods of assessment in Psychology, Basic Psychological Processes - Learning, Attention, Perception, Memory and Forgetting, Thinking, Reasoning, Decision Making, Problem Solving & Creative Thinking, Language, Motivation, Frustration and Conflict, Emotions and Personality.

Abnormal Psychology

Definition and Scope, History taking and MSE, Historical Conceptions of Abnormal Behavior, Approaches to Psychopathology. DSM V and ICD 10 Classification - Symptoms, Factors, Vulnerability: Organic disorders, Anxiety Disorders and Somatoform Disorders, Mood Disorders and Suicide, Psychotic Disorders, Dissociative Disorders, Substance Related Disorders, Mental retardation and other childhood Disorders. Mental health –Intervention models. Psychotherapies - Different types.

Social Psychology

Definition and Scope of Social Psychology, Social Perception, Social Cognition, Social Influence, Prosocial Behavior, Group Behavior, Leadership, Attitudes, Applied Social Psychology - Law, Health & Environment.

Psychological Assessment

Test construction: Item writing, item analysis, Test standardization: reliability, validity and norms. Types of tests: Intelligence, Aptitude, Personality, Attitude scales and interest inventories, Educational measurement and evaluation.
