Alumnus Recalls....



Dr Chakradhar Sana, Alumnus of Department of Periodontology, is a private practitioner at "Sana Dental Clinic" at Vishakapatnam.

These are the excerpts of the interview the Editorial committee conducted. This is what he feels and expresses about the department.

You opting Postgraduation in Periodontology - was it by Choice?

Quite shockingly, no...I was very keen on Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics or prosthodontics, because I loved both these subjects and I was awarded in both of them. 
