Students should demonstrate:

Desire to learn

- 1. Display a positive attitude by viewing each class as an opportunity to learn something new.
- 2. Actively engage in gaining knowledge and skills from each class and assignment.
- 3. Structure time to make classes and studying a priority.
- 4. Be responsible for your own success.

Responsibility for Learning

- 1. Be engaged and active in class.
- 2. Stay informed about course requirements.
- 3. Use time and other resources wisely.
- 4. Complete and submit assignments on time.
- 5. Communicate with the module leader when you have questions.
- 6. Give the module leader and fellow students your complete attention during class.
- 7. Seek help in a timely manner.

Honesty and Integrity

- 1. Do your own work, without compromise.
- 2. Be honest in all communications, oral and written.
- 3. Cite sources appropriately.

Respect

- 1. Respect diverse opinions, backgrounds, and life experiences of others.
- 2. Show respect for instructors' knowledge, experience, and education.
- 3. Be punctual. Arrive on time and stay for the entire class.
- 4. Refrain from behaviours that may distract others.
- 5. Communicate with instructors outside of class at appropriate times and places.
